




in the answer list.


Here's how to solve the riddle.

Begin at the arrow. Fill in the missing word in each block. (Use the word list if you need help.) The silent letter in each word will appear over the numbered space.

When you have filled in all the words, put each silent letter into code. Press (a), (1) SECRET CODE,

and the letter key for the silent letter. Then press (f) ENTER. I'll change the silent letter into code. Put each coded letter into its numbered space in the circle. Press my (f) ERASE key before you do the next letter.

When you have finished, the answer to the riddle will appear!



You'll need two players, a pencil, a marker for the football, and paper.

Set a playing time and decide who goes first. Put the football marker on the 50 yard line.
Each player selects a goal. When it's your turn, press my


on and # MODULE SELECT keys. Choose a level, press that key, and o Spell the words I say.

Move the football 10 yards towards your goal for each correct spelling. Continue spelling until you fumble or score.

A misspelled word is a fumble. The other player "recovers" and spells the "fumbled" word. When that player spells the word correctly he moves the football the other way.

You score when you spell enough words to reach your goal. After you score, put the football on the 50 yard line and the other player starts his turn.

Add 6 points for each score. The player with the most points when time is up wins.



You will need two or more people and a marker for each player. Decide who goes first and put your marker on START.

When it is your turn, press my (??) LETTER kev. If I give you a consonant, move

your marker one cloud. If I give you a vowel, move your marker two clouds. Each time you land on a new cloud, do what it says. If you don't get the right answer, skip your next turn.

Remember, play this game with words in the Super Stumpers module. Pressing my(#) MODULE SELECT key gives you words from the new list. Pressing (#)

MODULE SELECT again tells me to go back to my builtin word list. Take turns until one

player reaches the landing strip and wins.










You'll need two people and lots of markers (like pennies or buttons). Select a board and choose who goes first. Press my (in) key. Press my LETTER key until I give you a consonant. (Remember that a consonant is any letter that is not one of the vowels. The vowels are A, E, I, O, and U.)

Use the consonant as a double letter to make a word in one of the boxes on your board. If you can use the word in a sentence, cover the square with a marker. If not, you lose the chance to cover a square. (You may not be able to make a word each time.)

The first player to cover all the squares on his playing board is the winner.





WHAT IS THE MYSTERY SOUND?

There is a mystery sound that sometimes turns words into SUPER STUMPERS. The sound is in all the words in the word list. But it can be spelled with any vowel.


Help me find the mystery sound.


