EASY TO OPERATE — Press the keys in the same order as the problem is written. Typical operating examples are on the back of your calculator.

BATTERY – A 9-volt alkaline battery is recommended for maximum life. A carbon-zinc battery may also be used though it should be removed immediately after being discharged to prevent possible damage from leakage.

AUTOMATIC CONSTANT—Addition, subtraction, multiplication or division with a constant number is automatic. The *first* number entered in multiplication will be the constant. The second number entered in the other three

functions will be the constant:

DECIMAL POINT—Automatically appears to the right
of any number entered unless the . key is used. The calculator automatically positions the point to display the

most significant digits of the result.

OVERFLOW NDICATION — A flashing display indicates that the result is more than eight digits to the left of the decimal. The calculator will not accept any key entries except the CE or C key. Press the CE key to clear only the overflow condition. The displayed number will remain for further calculation with the decimal shifted eight places to the left of its original position. To determine the correct placement of the decimal, mentally move it eight places to the right. Press the C key to clear all numbers and the overflow condition from the calculator.
